A mobile, modular and expandable energy solution that grows with the needs of the user, combines the simplicity of a solar home system with the power of a mini-grid.

IMPLEMENTATION

Lifeline and Power-Blox will work with local stakeholders to identify entrepreneurs who will employ 50 Power-Blox units, either to power their own enterprises (e.g. a hair salon, food stand, etc.) or to sell electricity as a service (for charging phones or leasing the unit out for household use).
